## **MCCL Federal PAC endorses Sen. John McCain for U.S. President**

*McCain has strong pro-life voting record, solid positions on life issues*

MINNEAPOLIS – The Minnesota Citizens Concerned for Life Federal PAC has announced its endorsement of Senator John McCain for President of the United States. The MCCL Federal PAC is the state’s oldest and largest pro-life political action committee.

“The MCCL Federal PAC enthusiastically endorses John McCain,” said Scott Fischbach, MCCL Federal PAC. “His strong pro-life voting record and his positions on issues affecting life will make McCain a highly effective pro-life U.S. president.”

McCain has a solid voting record against abortion, having cast 31 pro-life votes since 1997. (McCain’s voting record can be viewed on the NRLC Web site: [www.nrlc.org](http://www.nrlc.org).) This includes votes to uphold the Mexico City Policy that prevents the International Planned Parenthood Federation and other abortion-promoting organizations from receiving taxpayer dollars. McCain also has voted against endorsing the Roe v. Wade decision that legalized abortion on demand, and believes it should be overturned. Additionally, he voted to confirm U.S. Supreme Court Justices Samuel Alito and John Roberts.

In contrast, Democratic candidate Senator Barack Obama has strong positions and a voting record in favor of abortion on demand. He has pledged only to nominate Supreme Court justices who favor Roe v. Wade.

During the next presidency, one to three U.S. Supreme Court justices may retire; their replacements will determine the direction of the Court for generations to come.

Obama is a co-sponsor of the Freedom of Choice Act, a bill that would invalidate virtually all state and federal limitations on abortion and make partial-birth abortion legal again. If Obama becomes President of the United States, additional hundreds of thousands of unborn children will likely die each year.

While in the Illinois Senate, Obama even voted against saving the lives of babies who survive late-term abortions.

“There would be little or no protection for unborn babies, their mothers or other vulnerable lives if Barack Obama were in power,” Fischbach added. “Minnesota citizens must look beyond his charm and realize that Obama is an extremist who intends to promote and expand abortion on demand—and force taxpayers to pay for elective abortions.”

The choice for president is clear. The MCCL Federal PAC urges all Minnesota citizens to vote for Senator John McCain for President of the United States and to strongly oppose Sen. Barack Obama.
