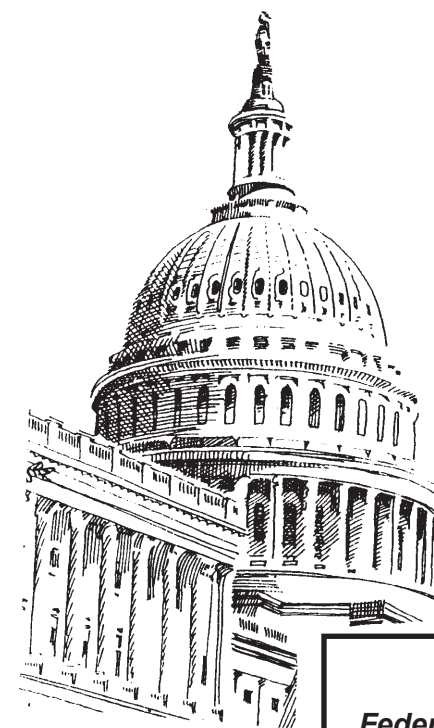

### The Impact of Your Contact

**Federal elected officials use the following rule of thumb:**

- each phone call to the local office represents 10 other people with the same opinion;
- each call to their Washington, D.C., office represents 500 people;
- each e-mail represents 100 people;
- each letter represents 500 people; and
- each visit represents 1,000 people.

### General Tips

- **Find your district numbers** at the Minnesota Secretary of State's website: <http://www.mnvotes.org>
- Be calm, reasonable, respectful and politely firm. Threats and open antagonism won't work.
- Know your elected official's voting record on life issues, political history and his or her relationship with MCCL. You can check [www.mccl.org/legislative-accountability-ratings](http://www.mccl.org/legislative-accountability-ratings), MCCL News or contact our office if you need help obtaining this information.
- **Thank your elected officials, especially when they vote pro-life!**
- If you don't have the answer to a question, don't sweat it! Let your lawmaker know you will get back to them, and then do so in a timely manner. Contact MCCL if you would like help finding the answer.
- **Please forward a copy of your communication as well as the response you receive from your elected official to MCCL. If you visited or phoned them, write up a summary, note what was said and forward a copy to the MCCL office. These are invaluable to our lobbying efforts.**
- No matter your contact method, your goal is to establish a relationship with your elected officials. For this reason alone, every contact is worthwhile.
- Call the MCCL office with questions or for any additional information. We are here to help you!

### Additional Tips for Visiting Elected Officials

- Be sure to make an appointment in advance and provide a list of who will be present.
- **Be on time!** You don't want to keep your elected official waiting.
- Stay on topic and avoid small talk. You'll want to get down to business as soon as you can, to make the most of the time with your elected official.
- Bring a few concise, reliable printed materials to leave with your lawmaker. You don't want to overload them with information they won't read.



## Additional Tips for Calling Elected Officials

- You may ask for the elected official, but expect to leave a brief message with an assistant.
- When leaving a message, make sure you let them know who you are (include your contact information), what issue you are concerned about, and specifically what you are asking of them. Ideally, these will be one sentence each.
- Indicate if you would like a response from the elected official.

## Additional Tips for Writing Elected Officials

- Time is of the essence when contacting your elected official. Email and fax are efficient ways to reach your lawmakers in a timely manner, but if you prefer to mail your correspondence make sure to allow time for it to reach your lawmaker before commitments on issues have been made.
- Brevity is important! You don't need to write an essay for it to make an impact. The shorter your message, the more likely your lawmaker will read it personally.
- Indicate if you would like a response from the elected official and always include your return address.
- If you are providing outside information or materials, make sure it is concise and from a reliable source.
